## DESCRIPTIONS

**Computer Animation\*** – Learn computer animation techniques from a graduate of the Digital Animation Center at the Univ. of Colorado.

**Art Club** – Have fun exploring and creating 2-D and 3-D art pieces.

**Math Tutoring** – Having trouble understanding your math? “Drop in” for some help OR attend weekly for more enrichment and tutoring.

**Recreation Zone\*** – Board games, movies, art projects, card games, play, listen to music, do homework - relax and have fun!

**Sports Zone\*** – Join us for some awesome sports fun - basketball, soccer, football, etc.

**Computer Club** – Have fun creating computer-based projects – all levels welcome.

**Martial Arts – Taught by Denver Parks and Recreation** – Learn the martial arts and become an expert!

**Scrapbooking** – Create some wonderful albums – use your own creativity to create some beautiful memories! (Maybe Morey Memorabilia!)

**Study Hall/Homework Assistance** – Complete homework assignments, read, check out books, and use the computer lab to complete assignments.

**Theatre Club** – Tryouts for theatre club will be in room 207. Student directors, actors, and set designers will be needed. In order to present a great production, **students must be comitted** in their attendance on **Wednesdays**. Additional days may be required for theatre rehearsals. Theatre does not begin until September 29<sup>th</sup>.

**Swimming** – Drop in and enjoy our pool. To participate, all students **MUST** have their swim physical on file at Morey. This is limited to 25 students. Be sure and bring your appropriate bathing suit and your own towel. Towels from the PE Dept. are not available.

**Yearbook** – Be a part of creating the Morey Middle School Yearbook! Students **must commit** to the club through its creation (March).

**Modern/Contemporary Dance - Colorado Ballet Company** – Learn beginning contemporary/modern dance and beginning choreography. The end product will be a dance specific to the students' interpretation of contemporary dance and choreography. Please note Tuesdays and Thursdays are different types of modern dance with two different instructors. Students are free to join both days or choose one. Please dress comfortably and be ready to move!

**Chess** – Be part of Morey's team! Learn basic and advanced moves and compete with other DPS schools.
